1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this methodology is to describe how to organize and conducting the admission contest to Preparatory Year for Romanian Language for Romanian Candidates from Everywhere, within OVIDIUS University of Constanta.

2. FIELD OF APPLICATION

This methodology is applied within OVIDIUS University of Constanta, in the July and September admission sessions, at Preparatory Year for Romanian Language of Romanian Candidates from Everywhere, in 2022-2023 academic year.

5. ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION

Art. 1

(1) The admission process for the Preparatory Year for Romanian Language will take place centrally at the university level, by the Admission Commission for Romanians from Everywhere (CARP).

(2) CARP will carry out the entire process of admitting Romanian candidates from everywhere, from registration to registration, inclusive.

(3) The registration of candidates will take place exclusively online (Annex 1), for all Romanians from everywhere, on UOC online registration platform for Romanians from everywhere:

<http://admitereonlinep.univ-ovidius.ro/>.

(4) Romanian candidates from everywhere are exempted from paying registration fees, file processing fees, as well as registration fees.

(5) The admission contest for Preparatory Year for Romanian Language takes place on the basis of a file competition.

Art. 2.

(1) Romanians from everywhere who do not know Romanian language can follow Preparatory Year for Romanian language either by admission contest to university studies, or by admission to the Preparatory Year for Romanian language (Section I – Admission to Preparatory Year for Romanian language), according with the legislation in force.

SECTION I – Admission at Preparatory Year for Romanian Language

Art. 3. The number of places allocated for Romanian candidates from everywhere is published on UOC admission website, at Romanians from Everywhere section:

Art. 4. Registration of candidates – submission of registration files

- a) The submission of the registration file is done exclusively online, on UOC online registration platform for Romanians from everywhere <http://admitereonlinep.univ-ovidius.ro/>, (Annex 1 – Submission of registration files);
- b) The registration file must include the documents specified in Annex 2 – List of required documents and Agreement on the processing of personal data (Annex 4);
- c) The candidates' files are verified by CARP;
- d) After the evaluation of the registration files, the selection of the eligible candidates is made;
- e) Candidates who submit all documents to the application file, in accordance with Annex 2, shall be considered eligible;
- f) Candidates who do not comply with the requirements of Annex 2 regarding the documents to be submitted to the file, will not be able to register to participate in the admission contest of the current session.

Art. 5. Admission and ranking average

- a) The admission average is the average of the baccalaureate exam (or equivalent);
- b) The ranking of candidates is made in descending order of admission averages, on the allocated places (Annex 3c – Application Form for Registration for Preparatory Year for Romanian Language 2023);
- c) In the case of equal averages of admission on the last place, the selection criteria is the average of the years of high school studies (or equivalent).

Art. 6. Admission contest results

- a) *The result of the admission competition* will be published on UOC admission page, at Romanians from everywhere section <https://admitere.univ-ovidius.ro/romani-de-pretutindeni/>.
- b) Candidates declared admitted who do not confirm the place occupied in the contest by register within a maximum of 48 hours from the display of *Results*, according to admission calendar and announcements accompanying the *Results*, will lose the place obtained through the admission contest.

Art. 7. Enrollment

- a) Candidates declared admitted must complete and submit to the CARP the documents provided for letter b), within a maximum of 48 hours from the display of *Results*, according to admission calendar and announcements accompanying the *Results*. Otherwise, they will lose the place obtained through the admission contest.
- b) The registration of the admitted candidates is made at CARP and consists of:
 - completing of Annex 7 (Study place confirmation form);
 - completing the registration application;
 - completing the study contract;
 - proof of payment of min. 25% of the tuition fee, according to the provisions of the study contract – for the candidates declared admitted on the place with a fee in LEI;
 - submission of original study documents, according to Annex 2.
- c) The number of the study contract is given by CARP in the unique CARP Registration Register; after sending the candidates' files to the secretariat of the Faculty of Letters, the study contract will be registered at the in the Registration Register of the Faculty of Letters.

Art. 8. Completion of the admission contest

- a) At the end of each session of Admission Competition, CARP will send to ME-DGRIAE the *List of admitted and enrolled candidates, as well as their files*, in order to issue the schooling approvals for each admitted candidate (student).
- b) At the end of the Admission Contest, CARP will send to the Faculty of Letters *The Final Result of the admission contest* and the files of the admitted and enrolled candidates, including the schooling approvals.

SECTION II – Final provisions

Art. 9.

If there are applications, UOC may request the ME to supplement the allocated places for Romanian candidates from everywhere for Preparatpry Year for Romanian Language.

Art. 10.

- (1) Romanians from everywhere enrolled at studies in Romania have the following obligations:
 - a) to respect Romanian Constitution and the laws in force of the Romanian state;
 - b) to comply with UOC regulations;
 - c) to comply with provisions of this methodology;
 - d) to present at General Inspectorate for Immigration within the Ministry of Internal Affairs, in order to obtain the residence permit in Romania for the entire period of studies.
- (2) In case of violation of provisions provided at the paragraph (1), as well as at the proposal of UOC, ME may withdraw the funding for the person concerned.

Art. 11.

Facilities offered to Romanian students from everywhere:

- a) financing the tuition expenses for Preparatory Year for Romanian Language and the monthly scholarship, as the case may be;
- b) financing the tuition expenses for the entire duration of the university cycle for which a monthly scholarship was admitted, as the case may be;
- c) financing the accommodation expenses in the student dormitories, through ME budget, within the allocated subsidy;
- d) free medical assistance in case of medical-surgical emergencies and diseases with endemic-epidemic potential, according to the laws in force;
- e) transport in the same conditions as for Romanian students, according to the laws in force.

Art. 12.

During the admission sessions, as well as in the interval between them, the Central Admission Commission decides exclusively regarding all the problems, according to the laws in force.

Art. 13.

This methodology may be reviewed, depending on the legislative regulations following approval.
